## CV OF PROFESSOR DR. Amit Dey

Dr. AmitDey is the <u>Asutosh (Chair) Professor of Medieval and Modern</u> <u>Indian History</u>, in the Department of History, University of Calcutta, India. Head of the Dept. of History, & Present Ph.D. RAC Convener in History, C.U. and IDSK, Kolkata.. He is the Jt In Charge RUSA at Alipore Campus of CU. He received a Ph.D. in History in September 1999 from the University of London for his work on *The Image of the* Prophet *in Bengali Muslim Piety; 1850-1947* and completed his doctoral research as a Commonwealth Scholar being affiliated to the Department of History, Royal Holloway, University of London. His area of specialization is *Islam and Islamic Mysticism in Medieval and Modern South Asia*. He consults relevant Persian, Urdu, Bengali and English sources for this purpose. Published works include (4 books): *Sufism in India* (1996), *The Image of the Prophet in Bengali Muslim Piety*;1850-1947. (2006), *Islam in South Asia* (2016) and one co-edited book, *Between Tradition and Modernity; Aspects of Islam in South Asia*. (2011).

Prof. Dey is the co-editor of the Bengali Academic journal; *Itikotha* and the Resident Editor of *Indo Iranica*. The Comprehensive History of India Society (CHIS) has selected him as the Joint Editor for Volume X.

Dey has published over 70 articles on Islam and Islamic mysticism in academic journals. He delivered lectures in famous institutions such as the University of Chicago, North Carolina State University, Louisiana State University, University of California, Santa Barbara, University of Heidelberg, University of Roma, University of Uppsala, Victoria

At present, eight scholars are carrying out their Ph.D. research under his supervision. Apart from examining Ph.D. thesis submitted in Indian and foreign Universities, Prof. Dey also acted as subject expert during the selection of Asst. Professors, Associate Professors and Professors in Indian and foreign Universities. He served Visiting Professors in North Eastern Hill University, NEHU and as Visvabharati, W.B. He also acted as an expert during postgraduate syllabus framing in Bengal and Tamilnadu. Internationally renowned publishers sought his expertise to get their manuscripts reviewed. Prof Dey was invited by Indian and Bangladeshi TV channels to take part in programmes related to composite culture, folk and mystical traditions. He is serving as the External Expert of Higher Education Committees of nine Universities representing Bengal, North Eastern India, and South India. He has been awarded several international Fellowships which include Commonwealth Scholarship, Charles Wallace India Trust (both in UK), Baden Wuerttemberg Fellowship Fellowship

(Germany), U.S. Department of State Fellowship, Max Weber Centre Visiting Fellowship (Germany) and Linnaeus-Palme Exchange Programme ( three times in Sweden).
