



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

FACULTY OF COMMERCE, SOCIAL WELFARE AND BUSINESS MANAGEMENT UNIVERSITY OF CALCUTTA, INDIA

AND

LEEDS BUSINESS SCHOOL, LEEDS BECKETT UNIVERSITY, U.K.

Faculty of Commerce, Social Welfare and Business Management, University of Calcutta, India, and Leeds Business School, Leeds Beckett University, UK, recognizing the benefits accruing to their respective institutions by the establishment of a strong international relationship, hereby conclude this Agreement.

- 1. The purpose of this Agreement is to develop academic and educational collaboration and to promote friendly relations between the two institutions.
- 2. Both the institutions undertake to promote and develop cooperation with various activities such as those listed below, on the basis of equality and reciprocity.
 - (1) Exchange of faculty for research, discussions and lectures
 - (2) Exchange of graduate students
 - (3) Exchange of academic information and publications
 - (4) Conducting colloquia, lectures and seminars

- (5) Cooperation in research and the presentation of its results
- (6) Other forms of cooperation mutually agreed upon by both the institutions
- 3. In order to give effect to these forms of cooperation, representatives of individual departments, faculties, Schools and Centres within the two universities will be encouraged to consult with each other and to develop specific plans for collaboration in any or all of the ways mentioned in Clause 2 above.
- 4. It is understood that the implementation of any of the types of cooperation stated in Clause 2 above shall depend upon the availability of resources and financial support at the institutions concerned.
- 5. This MOU is made in English and this agreement will come into effect on the date when the representatives of both the institutions affix their signatures to the agreement and shall be valid for a period of five years. The validity of the Agreement may be extended after discussion by representatives of both the institutions, and such discussion shall be commenced not later than six months before termination of this Agreement.
- 6. The agreement may at any time be revised or modified within that period by mutual consent. It may be terminated within the period by either party giving six months notice to the other.
